

Form Field Placeholders

Form field placeholders define where users can enter information such as text, dates, or checkboxes. The format for a form field placeholder is as follows:

`{sp{type, [optional] label, [optional] content, [optional] recipient_email, [optional] required}sp}`

Field Descriptions:

- **type**: Specifies the type of form field to be created. Options include:
 - TB: TextBox
 - IB: IBAN Field
 - DB: Date Box
 - CB: Checkbox
 - Required: Yes
- **label (Optional)**: Defines the label displayed for the form field. This provides a visual cue to the user about what information is expected.
 - Example: Name
 - Required: No
- **content (Optional)**: Prefills the form field with the specified content. Useful for providing default values or examples.
 - Example: John Doe
 - Required: No
- **recipient_email (Optional)**: The email address of the recipient assigned to the form field. If not provided, the field is unassigned and can be filled out by anyone with access to the document.
 - Example: john.doe@example.com
 - Required: No
- **required (Optional)**: Indicates whether the form field is mandatory for the user to fill out. If set to true, the form cannot be submitted until the field is completed.
 - Example: true
 - Default Value: false
 - Required: No

Usage: To include form field placeholders, simply insert them into your document and configure the fields as required.
